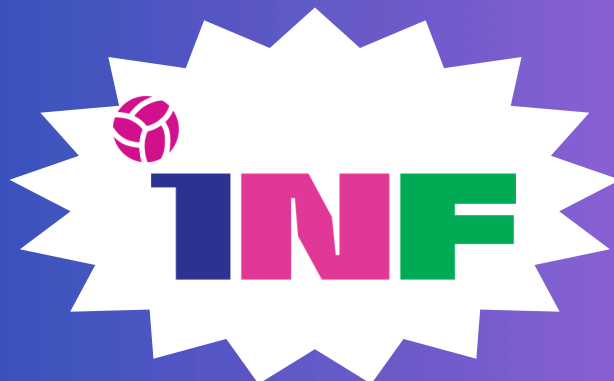

**TENTS: Tents are provided for travelling teams only, that have booked a tour package with INF. Each tent will be numbered. All teams are to collect their tents from the clubhouse and sign when you take one and return it. Please set up and take down the tent each day and return the neatly packed tent plus all the pegs and rope to the storage location before leaving each day.**

**Lunches on Match Days for players that have ordered and paid as part of the tour package, will be delivered to the clubhouse. Only two people from your team are required to collect the lunches. We will announce when the lunches arrive. Two team representatives will sign for the number of lunches received that have been ordered and prepaid.**

**First Aid**

**Clean Up**

All teams will be given a black rubbish bag each day. Please be respectful and if you see rubbish, pick it up and pop it in the bag or a rubbish bin.

**Awards Presentation** will be held immediately after the finals. 1st, 2nd or 3rd sportsmanship awards & MVP's (1 per team).

# COMPETITION RULES

## **Registration**

Maximum of 10 players per team

Players must be registered and have paid before THEY TAKE TO THE COURT to play in the International Netball Festival

## **Playing in a Division**

Players are not permitted to play in more than one team. Once players are registered in a team, they must stay in that team. If injuries it will be assessed.

Players are not permitted to play down or across a division.

***Matches will consist of two 12-minute halves with rolling substitutions.  
1 minute break at half time - 4 minutes between games***

## **Divisions with Pools**

- If Divisions are divided into two pools, each pool plays a separate round-robin competition.
- Following the round-robin stage, teams will progress to the Finals Day crossover matches.
- The top two teams from each pool will have the opportunity to qualify for Semi finals, the winners thru to the Grand Final and losers play off for 3rd/4th .
- All remaining teams will participate in matches to determine final competition placings. E.g. teams finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> in the round robin pool play with play off for 5-8th placings etc. on finals day. Etc. Each team will play two games on the Finals Day.

## **Stand-alone divisions**

- 1st place vs 4th place
- 2nd place vs 3rd place
- The winners of these matches will progress to the Grand Final.
- Teams that do not qualify for the Grand Final will play classification matches to determine their final competition placings.

## **Finals**

All 1st, 2nd, 3rd placing teams' players must sign in at the club House on Finals Day. Before the game.

**New players will not be allowed to join a team on the Finals Day.**

# COMPETITION RULES

## **Injuries**

Once a player has played up for two games, they will then be part of this team. They cannot play down again. If there are injuries and one team does not have enough players and wishes to pull a player from another team across the division, we will assess this at the time.

## **Boys**

Boys (13 years or under) can play in the 13/U Division only. There can only be three (3) boys on the court at any one time in a team—one boy in each third of the court e.g Centre court (WA WD C), Shooters or circle defender.

## **Scorers and scorecards**

Score sheets will be placed on a clip board in the centre circle on the court for the day. Please replace it back to centre circle after each game. Winning team take scoresheets only to the Club House - leave the clip board at the court.

A scorer from each team must be supplied.

Scorers must stand beside each other on the sideline.

Please have teams fill in Umpires award on the scorecard. These are fun awards for umpires as they make the game happen. We like to thank them. Umpires to sign and fill in points for Team Sportsmanship Award.

Points Table will be on the INF website and facebook.

## **Rolling Substitutions**

- The rolling substitution stands at the designated area in front of their own coaching bench.
  - SUBSTITUTE TAGS PLAYERS HAND BEFORE TAKING the COURT near the transverse line
  - ONLY ONE ROLLING SUB at a TIME per team can be made NOT STOPPING PLAY for rolling substitutions. If play is delayed, the player will be penalised under the Rule of Delaying play.
  - Players must observe the offside rules as they enter/leave the court.
- Sanction: Free pass where the infringement occurred (offside area) unless this places the non-infringing team at a disadvantage, or advantage is applied.

• Players must not interfere with the umpire's movement during the substitution.  
Sanction: Free pass where the ball was when play was stopped (advantage may be applied).

## **Jewellery & nails**

Short fingernails - not visible from the underside of your finger

No piercings to be worn or taping

No watches, necklaces, bracelets, bangles

No other adornments that may endanger players safety

# COMPETITION RULES

## Rolling Substitutions

- The rolling substitution stands at the designated area in front of their own coaching bench.
- SUBSTITUTE TAGS PLAYERS HAND BEFORE TAKING the COURT near the transverse line
- ONLY ONE ROLLING SUB at a TIME per team can be made NOT STOPPING PLAY for rolling substitutions. If play is delayed, the player will be penalised under the Rule of Delaying play.
- Players must observe the offside rules as they enter/leave the court.

Sanction: Free pass where the infringement occurred (offside area) unless this places the non-infringing team at a disadvantage, or advantage is applied.

- Players must not interfere with the umpire's movement during the substitution.

Sanction: Free pass where the ball was when play was stopped (advantage may be applied).

## Jewellery & nails

Short fingernails - not visible from the underside of your finger

No piercings to be worn or taping

No watches, necklaces, bracelets, bangles

No other adornments that may endanger players safety



# COMPETITION RULES

## **Stoppages**

**Blood Policy:** Play shall cease immediately when blood is noticed. The player must leave the court immediately and may be replaced. The injured player may return to the court at the next centre pass if the blood flow has ceased, the wound cleaned and covered. If a shooter or centre is injured, the team may change one other player on the court to take that position. Stoppages are to be kept to a minimum.

**Injuries** There will be 30 seconds for minor injury. The player may be replaced. If a shooter or centre is injured, the team may change one other player on the court to take that position. Stoppages are to be kept to a minimum. They may re-enter the court after the next centre pass off, if they have not been replaced.

**Send off:** If someone has been sent off the court, they have to be off the court for a minimum of 2 minutes. They can go back on the court after 2 minutes, at the next centre pass off.

**Wet Weather** The INF President will make wet weather playing decisions. Games may be played in the rain unless a decision is made to postpone play. Safety is important.

*In the spirit of the game of netball*

# COMPETITION POINTS

Three (3) points for a win, two (2) points for a draw and one (1) point for a loss.

## **Tie in Competition Points**

If there is a tie with competition points at the end of competition, the team's placing in the ladder will be determined by the following, in this order:

1. The result of the game between the 2 teams – if that was a draw then,
2. A count back of goal difference - Goals For vs Goals Against. The team with the biggest goal difference will qualify ahead in the ladder – if this was equal then,
3. Fair play points as awarded by the umpires – if this is equal then,
4. A toss of the coin by the Festival Director with the 2 team captains. (The team who has travelled furthest to the Festival will call the toss)

## **Draw at the End of a Final**

The teams are allowed a 1-minute drinks break at the full-time whistle. There will be three (3) minutes extra time each way. No break, Rolling subs permitted. If it is still a draw, then it will be first team to reach a two (2) goal lead. **No breaks , rolling subs permitted.**

Coaches will nominate this player based on positive player that is valued in the team on and off the court. A player that showed fairness, encouragement, a positive attitude, friendliness and never gave up attitude

(give the name to an official at the club house on the last day)

**TEAM TROPHY**

**The winning team in each division will receive a team trophy**
