- Airport taxes, airline taxes, fuel surcharges are variable and will be confirmed at time
 of final invoice
- Quotes are valid for 14 days
- Rental vehicle quotes are based on drivers 25 years or older please contact us regarding drivers under 25 years of age as there is an additional fee
- There will be a minimum \$100.00 fee per person for any flight and/or itinerary changes once deposits are paid. Any additional flight costs will be charged
- The price is only guaranteed once the deposit has been paid
- If group numbers increase or flights are split, there will be an additional fee from the airline, which will be charged accordingly
- Independent return flights may be able to be split out of the group. An additional fee
 of minimum \$100.00 per person plus any increase in flight costs will be charged, if any

Accommodation:

Quote is based on single beds in **Private Boarding House** – BEDDING. Single beds, twin, triple or quad rooms, teams all in the same dorm.

Or \$120 more per person in an Apartment:

- Two bedroom with kitchen and laundry
 - Room 1: queen room with ensuite. Room 2: 2 single beds. **Girls share queen bed unless stated**. There will be a rollaway in each apartment
 - Officials in own apartment, unless otherwise stated
 - Bedding configuration based on a team of 12:
 - 1 x Quad-2 rollaways, 2 x triple-1 rollaway, 1 x twin



Cancellation Policy

- All change of mind and medical cancellations must be made in writing via email to INF.
- If a person has to cancel due to medical reasons or immediate family medical reasons, please contact the insurance supplier directly for information on making a claim.
- The best option is to replace the person to avoid any loss of monies.
- If airline tickets have been issued the minimum cost is aprox\$150 for a change of name on the ticket.
- The cancellation policy is based on your tour cost, less the below:
 - Deposits are non-refundable
 - 14 weeks from travel
 less 30% of tour cost paid per travelling person- subject to numbers
 that are reduced
 - 10 weeks from travel less 50% of tour cost paid per travelling person
 - 6 weeks from travel less 75% of tour cost paid per travelling person
 - 4 weeks from travel
 Sorry, no refunds

Cancellation Terms & Conditions

For cancellation that is voluntary (change of mind), Terms and Conditions apply as per our Cancellation Policy above.

Merchandise is non-refundable and a credit is unavailable.

On the postponement or cancellation of a tour due to occurrences outside INF control a group credit (if any) may be put towards an alternative tour with an expiry date (subject to airline and suppliers policies).

If a travel credit is issues by will be automatically applied to your booking. (Flights and other tour costs may be subject to change due to availability and cost at the time of booking) If any credit. They sit with the airline and the suppliers. INF can assist you in rebooking using that credit, in accordance with that airline or supplier's credit and booking Terms and Conditions when you are ready to travel.

Travel Insurance will need to be re-issued at the time of booking (a new premium cost payment will be required).

• Please note that supplier cancellation terms and fees may differ.

2. REGISTER YOUR TEAMS

Upon registration of your group, you will be sent an email with a link to provide the details of your teams, players and officials.

- 3. PASSPORTS (FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVELLING TEAMS) photocopies need to be handed to teachers/leaders to check spelling of names and expiry date. We are required to advise that the expiry date on your passport must be SIX MONTHS past the date you will be returning into your country (we will send you a spreadsheet from your airline to fill in)
- 4. **INSURANCE FORMS** required in case of injury before you travel or if someone in your group cannot travel (Please enter names and dates of birth on your group's online registration)
- 5. 60 DAYS BEFORE TRAVEL (we will send you forms and reminders for the below)
 - Please complete the spreadsheet received upon registration to provide:
 - 1. Polo and Singlet Size
 - 2. Special Meal Requests
 - 2. Names for ticketing (we will send you a spreadsheet from your airline to fill in)

3-4 WEEKS BEFORE TRAVEL

- Final itineraries with address, times, any updates on flights (if required)
- E-tickets
- Information for pick up details for rental mini buses
- Please send us by email:
 - Driver form for rental vehicles (domestic travel only)




